 - H. Postupack made the following motion regarding guidance for the Dresden school budget:

Acknowledging that a flat to slightly decreased student enrollment is projected for both RMS and HHS for FY2013-14, it is the recommendation of the Dresden Finance Committee that the total Dresden operating budget should be held flat or modestly reduced, in line with the projected student enrollment, in an effort to contain per-pupil costs. Recognizing that individual line items may increase independent of other trends, the School Board will need to find reductions in other

areas to achieve a flat or modestly reduced Dresden net operating budget. This guidance is meant to enable Dresden's cost per student to trend down toward historic levels.

Seconded by K. Fenner. There was some discussion regarding the historical cost per student information. For 7 Against 1 Approved
