

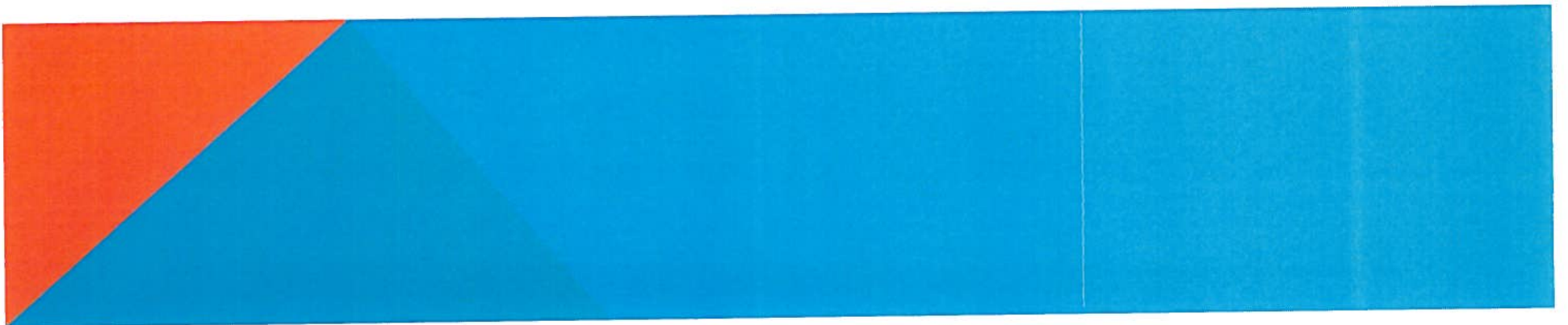

# SURVEY HIGHLIGHTS

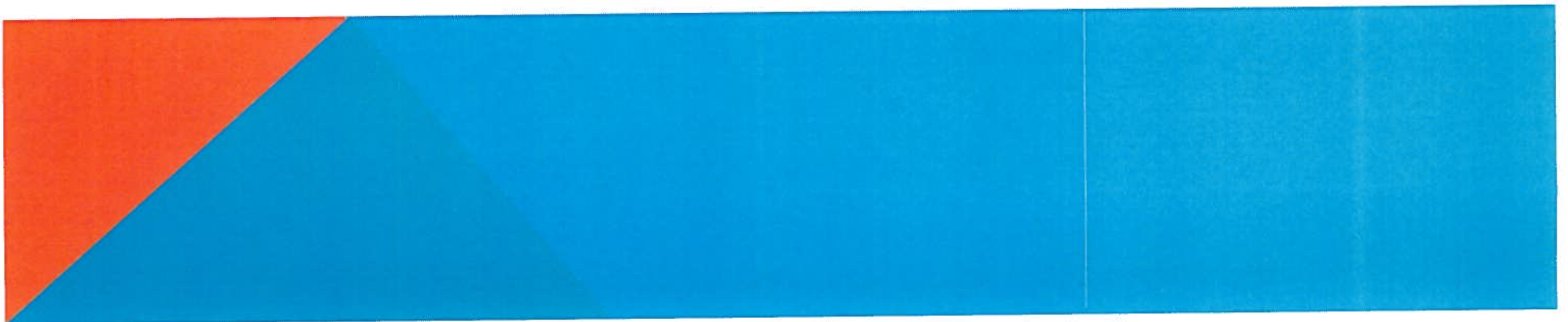
- New survey questions – Sarah Miles

# GENERAL THEMES:

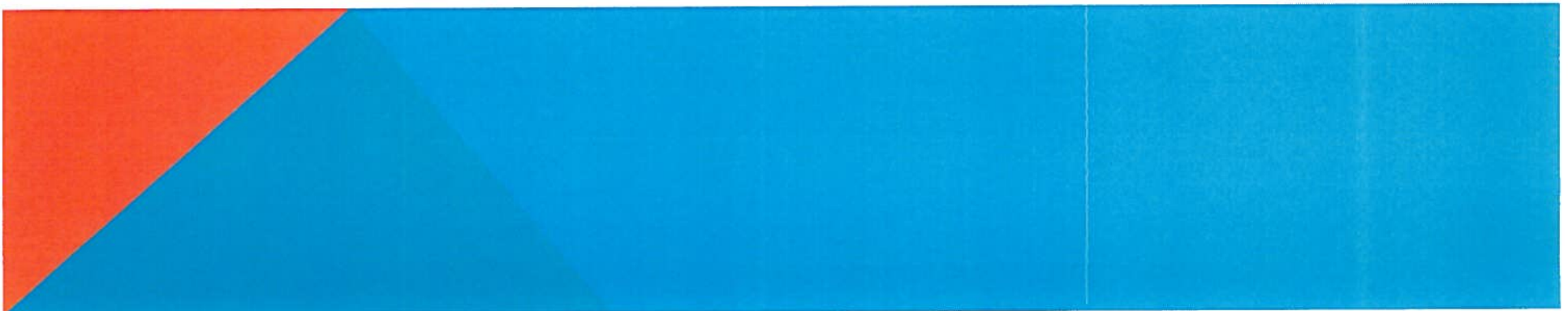
## 90% OR HIGHER – STRONGLY AGREE OR AGREE

# AREAS TO LEARN MORE ABOUT

- **Specials Program** – 29% of respondents state our special programs meet student interests fairly, mildly, or not well at all.
- **Learning Style** – 26% of respondents state teaching styles match student learning styles fairly, mildly, or not well at all.
- **Asking for Help** – 37% of respondents state students feel comfortable asking for help somewhat comfortably, mildly comfortably, or not comfortable at all.
- **Technology** – 41% of respondents state that technology is somewhat important, a little important, or not at all important.
- **Relevancy of Topics** – 29% of respondents state topics covered in classes are somewhat relevant, a little relevant, or not at all relevant.



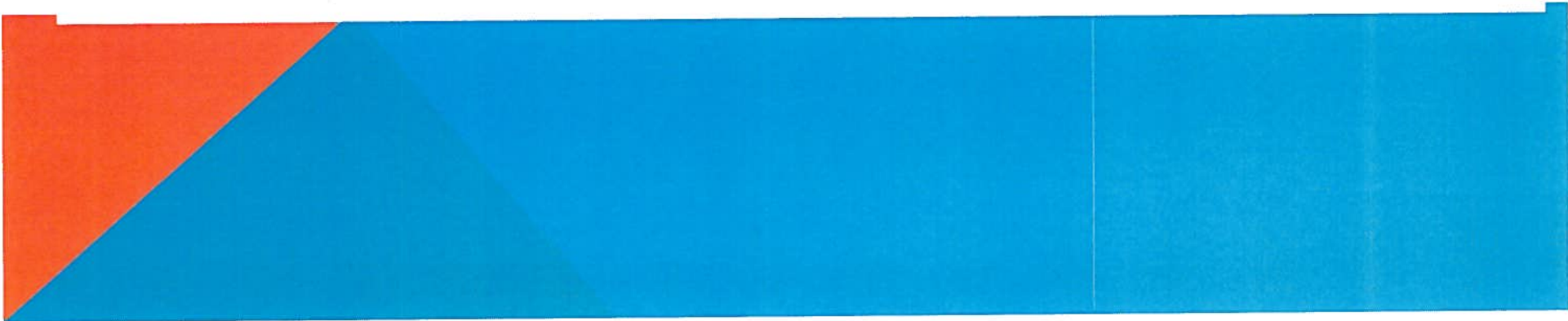
