To: Parents of Students riding Hanover Route 6 and 7

As you may know, both the transportation service provider (Student Transportation of Vermont) and I are new this school year. We have both been working diligently to make appropriate changes to notification processes, routes and stops to make them most effective and comply with best practices. We will be reviewing all routes and stops this coming summer.

Due to recent traffic events in the Lebanon Street bus stop area, we have been working with the Town of Hanover to make decisions in the best interest of the students being picked up. Effective Monday, April 3, starting with the morning (A.M.) runs, the following changes will occur:

- The two (2) stops on Bus H-7 at Carter & Crowley and #5 Crowley Terrace will now transfer to Bus H-6 (see H6 route listing).
- Stop #81 Lebanon Street (#81/83/89) will transfer to Bus H7 and pick up on the “odd” side of the road; a new stop will be added at #82 Lebanon Street (#82/84) and will pick up on the “even” side of the road. No students should cross this section of road to be picked up (see H7 route listing).

The students should ride the same bus routes they are picked up on in the PM to be dropped off. The PM stop/drop-off for the “odd” numbered side of this section of Lebanon Street will be at #83. The bus will then turn around at the Hanover Town Yard and drop-off students at #82 on the “even” side of the road.

We have also updated the other route listing locations and times to actual based on current information. As always, drop-off times are approximate and may vary due to volume of riders and volume of traffic.
